

Article 13. 12. Termination, suspension and reinstatement of student status

1. The basis for suspending student status is:

A) personal statement (without giving reasons);

B) study at a higher education institution in a foreign country, other than exchange

Learning within the educational program; C) pregnancy, childbirth, child care;

D) deterioration of health; E) financial debt;

F) academic leave;

G) failure to register for academic (program and elective courses). 2. The maximum term of student status suspension is 5 years.

3. In case of status restoration, the student continues his studies from the semester from which the student status was suspended.

4. In case of non-payment of tuition fees, suspension of student status does not relieve the student of the obligation to pay the tuition fee.

5. The student's status shall be terminated 5 years after the suspension of the student's status.

6. In case of status restoration, the student continues his studies from the semester from which the student status was suspended (if the student has no academic debt). Restructured student status at the University is carried out before the beginning of the semester or the beginning of the semester on November 1 (fall semester) and April 1 (spring semester). If the student has passed the intermediate assessment components (intermediate exams, presentation, etc.) before the status is suspended, it can be restored to the final exam at any time during the semester (unless the student submits a written request to improve the intermediate grades). A student who has been suspended due to financial debt will be reinstated if the debt is fully repaid.

1. The grounds for termination of student status are:

A) suspension of status for more than 5 years while studying at the University; B) Completion of the educational program at the given stage;

C) personal statement;

D) failure to meet the requirements of the relevant educational program within the timeframe required to obtain an academic degree;

E) University Code of Ethics, University Regulations and Discipline

Implementation of actions incompatible with student status under the norms of responsibility, based on the decision of the Faculty Board;

E) moving to another educational institution; G) death;

H) other cases prescribed by law.

2. The legal effects of the legal act on termination of a student's status shall be drawn up twelve months after the order has been issued. At this point in time, student status is considered suspended and the student is entitled to the right to mobility.

3. In case of termination of the student's status, his / her re-acquisition is permitted in accordance with the procedure established by the legislation.

4. The individual legal act on termination or suspension of student status shall be issued by the Rector of the University upon the recommendation of the Dean.

5. A person who has not completed a relevant educational program and has been suspended from a student status shall be given a certificate.
