Article 15. Registration in the Additional Semester and Approval of Additional Fees

- 1. The student has the right to re-undergo a separate training course within the terms of the educational program and within the framework of semester tuition for the amount of credits established by the semester work norm.
- 2. A student who has not attained a relevant academic degree within the timeframe specified in the educational program shall be entitled to complete the study program by self-financing for the next four semesters.
- 3. The tuition fee for an additional semester student is determined by the amount of credits in accordance with the semester fee, as follows:
- A) In case of completing the educational program planned for the semester, the fee will be determined by the tariff set for the current academic year;
- (B) The tuition fee for a particular course of study shall be determined by the amount of credit granted for the subject and the cost of one credit shall be as follows: Semester fee equal to 30.
- 4. During the additional semesters of undergraduate studies, the student is allowed to select 240 credits in the range of 30-45 credits so that the total number of credits in one academic year does not exceed 75.
- 5. During the additional semesters of the master's program, the student is allowed to choose 120 credits within 30-45 credits so that the total number of credits in one academic year does not exceed 75.
- 6. A Bachelor who, within the deadline set before the end of the semester, is an undergraduate thesis at the faculty and fails to defend for an honorable reason, is entitled, in the following, additional semester, to an academic degree.

Pay a service fee of GEL 50 within the timeframe specified in the calendar and follow the undergraduate thesis within the period specified by the faculty.

- 7. A student who fails to accumulate the credits required for the award of an appropriate academic degree within the timeframe specified in the additional semesters shall terminate the student status and obtain the status of trainee, as evidenced by the academic report.
- 8. If the educational program is changed or canceled, the student will not be charged the credits required for the study of modules or modifications of the adjacent / related educational program.
